ESGO 2018 Scientific Spotlight

Small Cell and Neuroendocrine Tumours

Nicholas Reed, UK

True small cell carcinomas of the lower genital tract are very uncommon, constituting **less than 2% of all gynecologic malignancies**, and occurs most frequently in the cervix, but can also occur in the endometrium, ovary, and vulva.

The session will focus on some of the key insights on the Small Cell and Neuroendocrine Tumours, including:

- + Is **multimodality therapy** required for the majority of cases?
- + Are long-term remissions and cure only achievable in early stage disease?
- + Do more advanced disease carry a very poor prognosis? What efforts need to be made to identify **new treatment approaches**?

The key to this is likely to come from molecular profiling and identifying new target agents. Data and tissue collection and registries are key components of management together with international collaboration for clinical studies.
